As a community member living at St. Monica's, you have rights that are protected by the Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS). This section will highlight one of your rights each month. The full list was given to you upon moving in to St. Monica's. If you ever feel that any of your rights have been violated, please report this to administration as soon as possible. You have the right to the following:

"To make & receive telephone calls within reasonable limits & in privacy. The CBRF shall provide at least one non-pay telephone for resident use. The CBRF may require residents who make long distance calls to do so at the resident's own expense."


