






























### 13th Annual Golf Outing: A Swinging Success!

#### **Ingredients**

1 (9-inch) crust (store-bought) ¾ cup packed light brown sugar (165g) ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon

½ teaspoon ground ginger

½ teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/8 teaspoon cloves

½ teaspoon salt

1 (15-ounce/425g) can pumpkin puree 1 (12-ounce/354ml) can evaporated milk

3 large eggs at room temperature

#### Instructions

Place pie shell/crust in a 9-inch pie dish. Preheat the oven to 400° F. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the sugar, spices, and salt. Then add the pumpkin, milk, and eggs. Whisk until well combined. Pour the mixture into the pie shell. (You can brush the edges of the pie crust with an egg wash, if desired.)

Bake for 15 minutes. Reduce the oven temperature to 350° F.
Continue baking until the filling is puffed and jiggles slightly in the center when gently shaken, about 40 minutes. Remove from the oven and let cool completely on a wire rack. If making ahead, cover and refrigerate for up to 2 days before serving.
